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Notice to Mariners.—We learn by a notice from the Custom House, at Darien, that the Light House on the north end of Sapelo Island and the beacons on Wolf Island cannot be lighted for some time, owing to the damage sustained by the late destructive hurricane. “The Beacons on Wolf Island cannot be re-lighted for the present; the injuries sustained by the establishment has been very great, the loss of the Light House Lantern stove in by the gale, and the lighting apparatus torn from its position and greatly injured; the sea running from six to eight feet in the Light House, breaking down the door, and destroying nearly the whole of the oil, taking away the one half of the keeper’s dwelling house.”

On Wolf Island the lower beacon and the keeper’s house, containing all his little property were entirely swept away. The keeper with his wife and two children saved themselves by getting in the lantern of the brick beacon, where they remained thirty-six hours without food, and though their house was only ten feet from the beacon, they were not aware of its destruction until morning. The door of their place of refuge was stove in,

the sea breaking from ten to twelve feet,
which destroyed the whole of the oil.
