

**CHARLES RUSSELL EXAMIN-
ED BY BOARD IN
KEY WEST**

Charles H. Russell, who was the steward on the Lighthouse Tender Ivy, has been declared insane by a board consisting of Dr. H. C. Galey, Dr. Vilo C. Pintado and J. G. Piodela.

Russell was reported to the sheriff's office several days ago and a sanity commission immediately appointed to examine into his condition and report to County Judge Hugh Gunn.

The commission finds that the patient is insane, suffers from hallucinations of grandeur and, while not violent, is considered dangerous.

Judge Gunn has communicated the declared condition of Russell to Dr. R. W. Hart, chief surgeon at the Marine hospital, and asked if he could not be cared for at that institution.

In the note to Dr. Hart the judge cites the condition at the hospital for the insane at Chattahoochee and the instructions that only those who are violent will be admitted, because of the overcrowded condition at that institution.
